

Note that the temperatures and weather in the Blue Mountains can be different to those in Sydney. You'll normally find the mornings and late afternoon colder than you may be expecting, so bringing a warm layer is definitely advised, particularly in winter months. A waterproof or windproof jacket and sturdy footwear for walking will also be a great idea.

8:00 AM -

Meet your Sydney Bespoke Tours guide in your hotel lobby to begin your day of private, tailored touring. It's a 90 minute drive into the Mountains, so relax and let your guide explain some of the fascinating history of this area as you travel. Remember also, this day is all about *you*, so discuss your interests and preferences with your guide so the day can be customised to suit you.





Walking in the footsteps of Charles Darwin, at Wentworth Falls

Your time in the Mountains today will be a great chance to get into nature to explore the Australian bush and wildlife. This will be a very personalised and unique day, as you follow in the footsteps of the world's most influential naturalist, Charles Darwin.

Arriving in the Mountains you'll meet Chris Darwin, great-great-grandson of the famous evolutionist. A fascinating character in his own right, Chris is a local to the Mountains and has an intimate knowledge of his famous forebear's theories, history and exploits. Today you'll walk in Charles Darwin's footsteps, following the path that he took when he visited Wentworth Falls in 1836, while he was staying in Sydney during the *Beagle* expedition. It's not hard to imagine the effect that Australia's unique flora and fauna had on Darwin's thoughts. Today, there's still plenty of wildlife to see and hear in the surrounding bush, from lizards to an array of melodious, colourful and unique birds. We *won't* be shooting a platypus today however, as Charles Darwin did in 1836!





Lunch in the Mountains

At lunchtime we'll head to one of our favourite Mountain's restaurants where you will be looked after with a fabulous two-course lunch of great seasonal, local produce.





An afternoon of views and bushland

After lunch, the focus will be on getting away from the crowds to enjoy the wilderness, wildlife and views in the way that best suits you. See the blue haze that gives the Mountains their name, view the quiet countryside of the Megalong Valley from Hargraves Lookout, or take a walk on one of the beautiful bush tracks around Pulpit Rock or Govetts Leap in the Grose Valley. With a flexible schedule, our time is easily personalised to bring out the best for you, and accommodate your own interests in hiking, wildlife, history, ecology or whatever takes your fancy, co-ordinated by Chris Darwin and your Bespoke guide.

Helicopter return option

In the late afternoon you'll meet your helicopter pilot for your scenic return to Sydney. This is a fabulous opportunity to get a true idea of the vastness of this World Heritage area, as you fly over the bushland, cliffs and gorges. Arriving into Sydney as the sun begins to descend you'll have spectacular views of Sydney Harbour and the city.

At the helibase you'll be met by a driver for a transfer by private vehicle to return you to your hotel. We hope you've enjoyed a fabulous day exploring the stunning Blue Mountains area, and thanks for letting us show you this special part of the world!





6:30 PM -

Sydney harbour cruise add-on option

In the late afternoon we will return towards Sydney by vehicle, where at the western arm of the harbour, our guide will hand you over to the skipper of an impressive Axopar sports cruiser.

This private 75 minute cruise will take you on a leisurely journey, showcasing many beautiful locations, with storytelling & interesting facts learned en route. At the conclusion of the cruise you will disembark at Circular Quay or Darling Harbour, where you can stroll back to your hotel.
