Meet your Sydney Bespoke Tours guide in your hotel lobby to begin your day of private, tailored touring. This day is all about *you*, so discuss your interests and preferences with your guide so the day can be customised to suit you.



Travel up the Northern Beaches to West Head

This morning, crossing over across the Harbour Bridge to the north shore, we'll travel through Sydney's leafy northern suburbs and up the coast via the long stretch of beaches that line the coast. There are plenty of stunning views to be found here, looking out over the Pacific Ocean, with the chance to spot whales during the migration season from May to November.

On the northern outskirts of Sydney we'll find West Head, looking out over the waterways of Pittwater and the Hawkesbury River. Combining important culture and history with scenic beauty, this region makes it perfect for a day away from all the hustle and bustle of the city - feel at one with nature without leaving Greater Sydney.

We can very much tailor the day towards your preferences. We'll take in the stunning views at West Head, and have a great chance to see some Australian wildlife like goannas, swamp wallabies and perhaps lyre birds – known as the 'bush mimic' for their incredible ability to imitate the other animals and sounds of the bush. We have wonderful options for some great bushwalks – take a quick walk to some beautiful viewpoints, or strap on your hiking boots for some spectacular hiking amongst the bushland, beside pristine waters. This is a great chance to learn about Aboriginal culture also, with easy access to Aboriginal engravings – some of the largest ancient petroglyphs of their kind in the world.



Lunch by the water at Cottage Point

Heading to the small but stunning waterside township of Cottage Point, we'll find the picturesque Cottage Point Inn. This pretty little restaurant sits beside the water in Ku Ring Gai National Park, with full views of the quiet waters and surrounding bushland. Here you'll enjoy a five course degustation meal with matching wines - long and relaxed.

Optional seaplane flight return

As lunch ends, your seaplane will be winging its way in to the quiet bay, to dock right at the restaurant's edge at their private wharf. Board your plane for the flight back to Sydney – a spectacular chance to see the coastlines and long stretches of sand of Sydney's Northern Beaches, and Sydney Harbour from the sky as you arrive back in the city. Land on the water at Rose Bay, at Sydney's oldest Airport – the Seaplane base. Here a water taxi will be waiting to take you back up the Harbour to the city.

Enjoy the romance of returning to Circular Quay by water taxi, a very relaxing, and very Sydney end to your day. From here, it's a short stroll to your hotel, or you may wish to enjoy a drink at sunset from one of the great bars by the Sydney Opera House.
