9:00 AM -Meet your Bespoke Guide

Meet your Sydney Bespoke Tours guide in your hotel lobby to begin your day of private, tailored touring. This day is all about *you*, so discuss your interests and preferences with your guide so the day can be customised to suit you.



Explore the City & Eastern Suburbs

Begin your day with a walk through the historic Rocks area of Sydney, the birthplace of Colonial Sydney. Here a group of exhausted and bewildered convicts and their keepers began to build a nation. Learn about their early beginnings, and their interaction with the Aboriginal people who had already been calling this area home for millennia. Take in the views over Sydney Harbour from Observatory Hill as your guide explains Sydney's unique origins.

See the colonial, sandstone buildings of Macquarie Street, and take in the vibrant foreshore precinct around the Sydney Opera House and Circular Quay. See the parklands of the Royal Botanic Gardens, and the sublime lookout point at Mrs Macquarie's Chair - beloved for its fabulous Insta-worthy views. Travel through the dock areas of Woolloomooloo and on to the glamorous Eastern Suburbs. Here you'll find areas that have evolved from working class, to inner-city chic. Some of the city's best galleries, boutiques, restaurants and bars can be found here along with lovely Victorian-era architecture. In the harbour-side suburb of Rose Bay you'll find Australia's first airport, and still today the wonderful Seaplane Wharf.

At South Head, the dramatic sea-cliffs are the perfect vantage point from which to take in the sweeping views up Sydney Harbour towards the city, or out east to the Pacific Ocean. There are some lovely walks and hidden spots in this area.



Enjoy lunch by the sands of Bondi Beach...

At lunch time we head to Australia's most famous stretch of white sand - the famous beach and breaks of Bondi Beach. This is where locals and tourists alike gather to pay homage to the great Australian love of sun, sand and surf. Enjoy a casual café-style lunch in one of our favourite, beachside bistros, inclusive of a two-course meal and a glass of your favourite beverage.

After your lunch, you may like to get some exercise and take in the stunning views with a walk on the famous Bondi to Bronte Cliffwalk. This spectacular walking track is a locals' favourite, taking you past the iconic Bondi Baths and Icebergs Swimming Club, and on to hidden gems like Tamarama Beach and Mackenzies Point.



A private sailing cruise on Sydney Harbour with a local

In the afternoon, head to the harbour's edge to meet your skipper for a two-hour private cruise on Sydney Harbour. The beautiful sailing yacht will be yours to enjoy as you cruise the waters like a Sydney-sider, taking in the local passion of the harbour lifestyle.

Take a hands-on approach or just relax, breathing in the sights of Sydney Harbour and visiting places loved by locals. You'll cruise under Sydney Harbour Bridge seeing icons like the Opera House, Farm Cove and Mrs Macquarie's Chair from the water. This is a great opportunity for photos, or to get the run-down and gossip on Sydney real estate - a local obsession! See the starting base for the famous Sydney to Hobart Yacht Race in Rushcutters Bay, cruise past the spectacular private homes at Darling Point, Point Piper and Vaucluse, and learn about the small islands dotted throughout the harbour. People are often amazed by just how much life takes to the harbour, as you see ferries carrying commuters, working ships coming and going, and a plethora of small and large pleasure craft just getting out to race or enjoy the water. You should even keep an eye out for penguins, seals, dolphins and whales! Light refreshments are included, making it all rather a wonderful thing to do at the end of the day!
