

Meet your Sydney Bespoke Tours guide outside the Sydney Harbour Marriott hotel, to begin your day of wildlife exploration.

Depart Sydney for the 90 minute drive south to the picturesque town of Bowral. En route, learn about the animals we are likely to find, some we might spot, and how we will record any sightings.





Wildlife in the Wild

On arrival, enjoy a light lunch before learning about local wildlife conservation projects, monitoring programs, and the signs to look for when tracking our more elusive wildlife. The rest of the afternoon will be spent spotting wildlife at several locations. The area hosts an abundance of birds - from the universally-loved Kookaburra to a host of colourful parrots, including Crimson Rosella, Eastern Rosella, Galah, Yellow-tailed and Glossy Black Cockatoo, and even Emu - as well as some of our most iconic animals, such as Echidna.





Kangaroos & wombats

Come late afternoon, it's the best time to see Platypus, Eastern Grey Kangaroos, and Bare-nosed Wombats as they emerge from their burrows to graze. Then after sunset, with the help of red-tinted spotlights, nocturnal marsupials, such as Ring-tailed Possums and Sugar Gliders, can be spotted in the trees.

In the evening, enjoy a well-earned dinner at an historic pub, before returning to Sydney.

Note: To ensure the best nature and wildlife experience possible for our travellers, the exact itinerary may vary on any particular day considering recent wildlife sightings and weather conditions.
